





Dazzling Desert Diorama





For the diorama, materials required:

- a shoebox and some construction papers
- Crayons and acrylic paints
- White glue and craft scissors
- Pencils and paint brushes •
- Sand and rocks

Learning outcomes : The learners :

1.list the names of various desert plants.

2.write the different characteristics of desert plants.

A desert plant is a plant which is suitable for the environment of arid regions with little rainfall. Desert plants have adapted to the excess of heat and aridity with help of physical and behavioral mechanisms, much the same to desert animals. The plants in desert areas have various modifications to prevent water loss. Their leaves are modified to spines to reduce transpiration. Usually photosynthesis is done by the stem. Students must showcase various desert plants like cactus, desert marigold, desert lily etc. in the DESERT DIORAMA . Students will write and explain the various characteristics of desert plants on A4 size sheet.

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The Thar Desert

Learning Outcomes:- Students comprehend desert environments, highlight the interplay between mathematical concepts and natural ecosystems.

CASE STUDY

The Thar Desert, located in northwest India, spans over 200,000 square kilometres of arid land. Despite its harsh environment, it supports a surprising diversity of plant life. In the heart of the desert lies an oasis, covering an area of 500 square meters, surrounded by sandy dunes.

Within the oasis, there are 20 date palm trees, 15 neem trees, and 10 khejri trees. Additionally, there are 30 shrubs, 40 grasses, and 25 flowering plants. Each date palm tree produces 50 kilograms of dates, while each neem tree has 100 leaves. The khejri trees provide shade for 5 animals each.

Each flowering plant produces 10 flowers. In total, there are 50 visitors to the oasis, and each visitor collects 3 flowers. There are also 20 birds in the oasis, each consuming 5 dates per day. Additionally, there are 100 insects in the oasis, each consuming 2 leaves per day.
